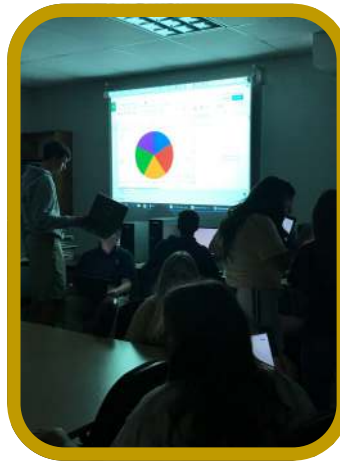
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Current Happenings

Office Applications has finished the semester with a unit on Microsoft Excel. Formatting cells, using formulas, and creating charts are some of the topics covered.

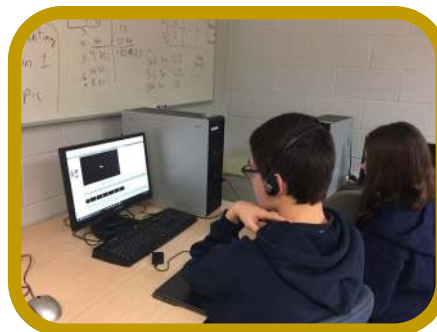

Coding class is working with transformations on their projects: rotating, scaling, and rotating within their code. Students are also working on adding buttons and scene changes in their code



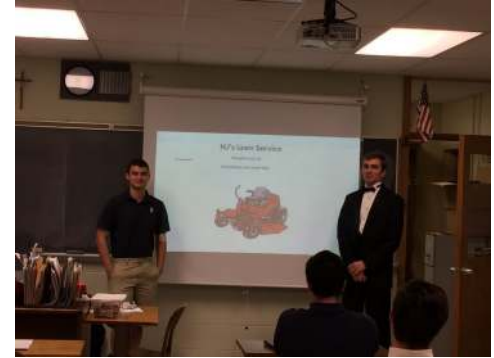
